County Commission choices

Ballot in the coming election features races in four of the commission's seven districts

The seven members of the Clark County Commission establish the policies that are carried out by the county manager. Four of the districts have races this election and all are being contested.

We believe the following candidates are the most qualified:

In District A, term limits mean that Clark County Commissioner Bruce Woodbury cannot seek reelection. Steve Sisolak, a Democrat and member of the state higher education system's Board of Regents, is facing Brian Scroggins, a Republican and former chairman of the Clark County Republican Party, in a race that has become increasingly negative.
